

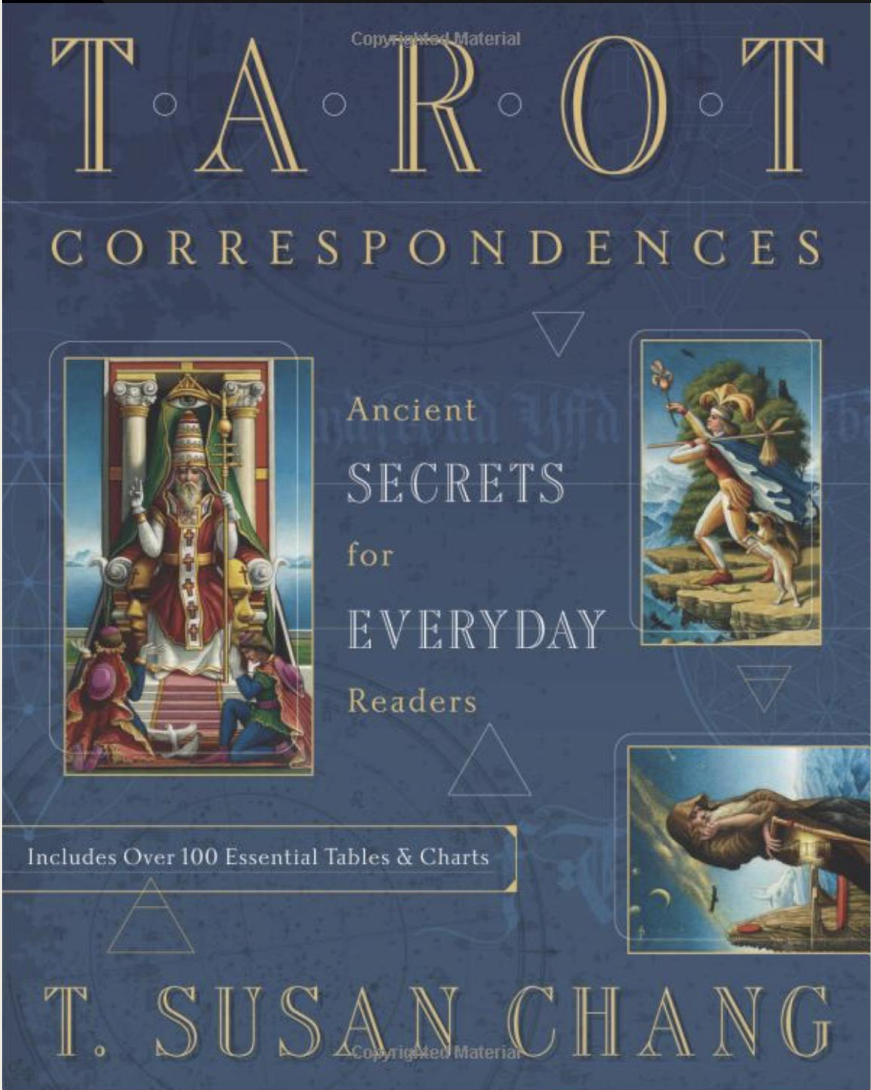

INTERPRETIVE TECHNIQUES: DRAWING OUT OVERALL THEMES IN EACH CARD

When you work with correspondences, it's as though you have a huge pile of little threads, each connected to another. The puzzle is to figure out how to weave them all together into an image that makes sense.

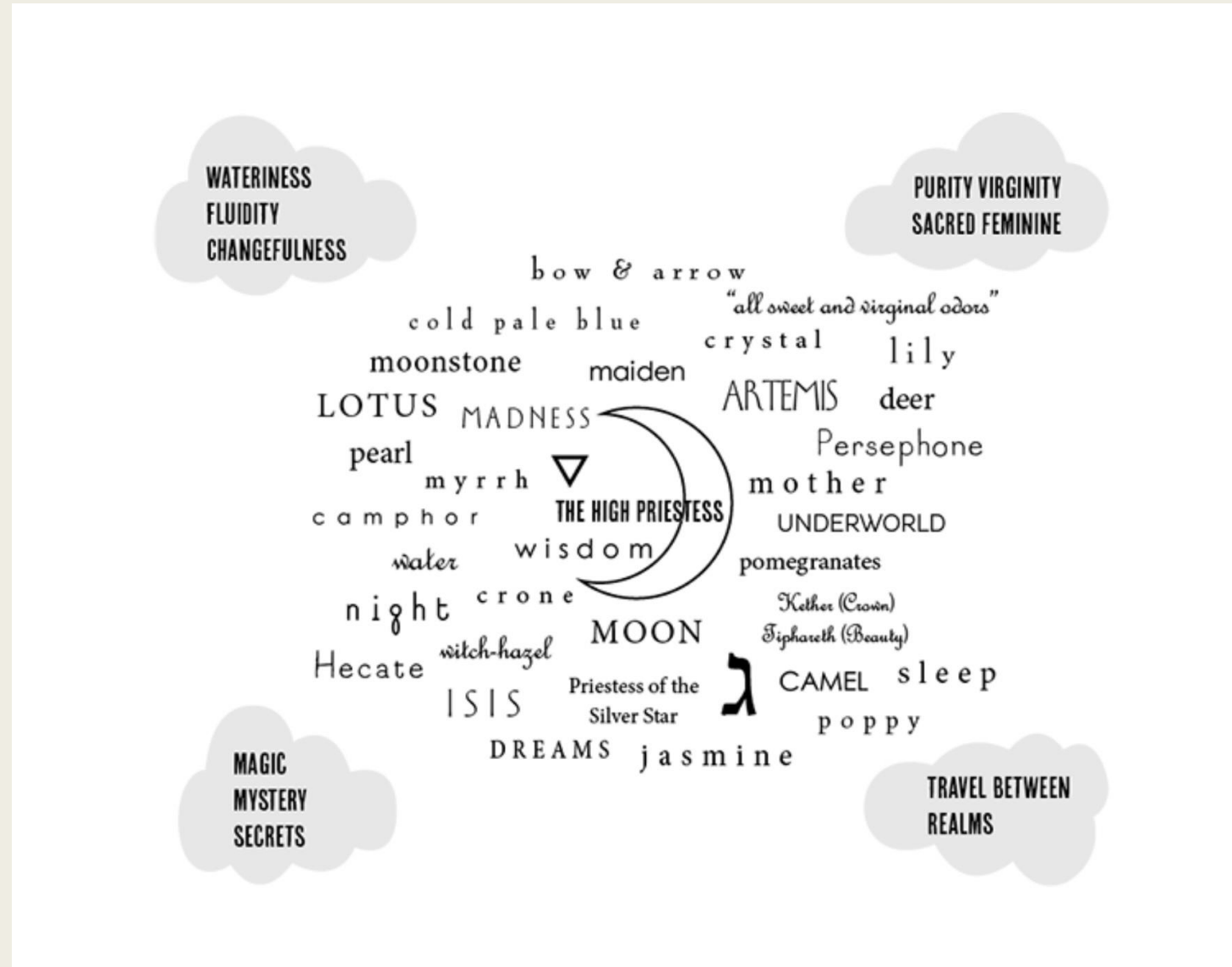
Suppose you're thinking about the High Priestess, everyone's favorite tarot divinity. Maybe you'll start with a table that looks something like this:

Multi-layered Approach – High Priestess



Benefits to studying

- Enhances readings style and interpretation
- Allows you to go deeper into esoteric/occult studies (layered approach)
- Details help with difficult questions aka
 - *Timing*
 - *Describing people can get down to colors*
- Combines with many other spiritual and healing modalities
- The better we speak tarot, the better readers we become... and less often we come up dry in a reading" (Pg.3 Tarot Correspondences T. Susan Chang)
- Examples of combinations:
 - Numerology
 - Astrology
 - Kabbalah
 - Non- Rider Waite tarot systems/writers: Thoth, Crowley, Marseille, Golden Dawn
 - Elemental Magic- Animal Plants, Nature, Crystals
 - Mythological/History

EXAMPLE CORRESPONDENCES TAROT SYSTEMS

Whichever of the three sources in legend, she continues to exert a strong influence on Tarot design. She is one of the strongest designs in the Major Arcana in both the Waite and Crowley decks, though in both she is more likely to represent the High Priestess of the Eleusinian Mysteries. (See Hierophant, card 5).

Design

Gringonneur: Missing

Bembo: A nun, wearing the triple crown and the habit of the Umiliata Order. She holds a breviary or Bible in her left hand. This is probably the earliest representation of The Papess in the Tarot and dates from about 1450

Swiss: Juno standing with her peacock. In many Southern French Tarots the Papess was replaced by Juno to avoid giving offence to the Church

Insight: A high priestess of Isis, seated on a throne. She holds a partially visible scroll with the legend, 'Tora', (Hebrew for Law). On her breast is a solar cross, at her feet a waxing crescent moon. She is flanked by lotus pillars. On the pillar to her right the word 'Boaz', is partially visible, signifying negation. On that to her left is the word, 'Jachin', or 'Beginning'

Marseille: A seated papess, wearing the triple crown, a book (The Bible) shown open on her lap

Italian: The same

Wirth: Similar to the traditional; but Wirth has added a crescent moon to the crown. Also, she bears the Keys of St. Peter

Waite: A priestess of Isis, the solar cross upon her breast. The waxing crescent beneath her left foot. She sits between the pillars Boaz and Jachin and before a screen decorated with pomegranates. In her lap is a rolled scroll of the Tora. On her head is a crown signifying waxing, waning and full Moon and probably The Triple Goddess as well

B.O.T.A.: As Waite, except that the pillars between which the priestess sits are lotus buds rather than opened flowers to signify her virginity, that is, latent or undeveloped powers

Aquarian: A pensive priestess sits before a curtain figured with pomegranates. In her left hand are several flowers. Two rods stand on her left, signifying Boaz and Jachin

Crowley: Isis enthroned. Isis because she has in her lap the bow and

arrows of the Virgin Goddess. On her head the crown of Isis. Between her and the viewer is a screen, before which are grapes, a lotus, crystals, a cone and a camel

New: Retitled, 'Mother'. A nearly naked woman stands astride the two pillars, one light, one dark. In her upraised left hand is a lotus, in her right a lightning bolt. Between her breasts is a seven-pointed star, she is crowned with the double-headed snake. Over her head is the sign of Aquarius

Interpretation

Case: The Hebrew letter, Gimel, meaning Camel. The Moon Uniting intelligence. Memory, the subconscious. Potential

Christian: Truth hidden. Discretion

Crowley: Camel. Luna. Uniting intelligence. The high priestess. Blue. Hathor, the left eye. Chandra. Artemis, Hecate. The dog or almond, mugwort, hazel, ranunculus, moonwort. Moonstone, pearl and crystal. Her weapons are the bow and arrows. Her perfumes are menstrual blood, Camphor, aloes, all sweet virginal odours. Her drugs are Juniper, pennyroyal, and all emmenagogues. Her powers are clairvoyance or divination by dreams. Her name is The Priestess of the Silver Star. The possibility of form, potentially a goddess of fertility. The idea behind form. Lineal figure, the Enneagram. Pure, exalted and gracious influence. Change, alternation, fluctuation, increase and decrease. A liability to be overwhelmed by enthusiasm

Douglas: Inspiration, revelation, divination, intuition. A wise or prophetic woman giving good advice. Emotional instability or enslavement. Lack of foresight, reluctance to take advice giving rise to problems

Gray: Traditional with reversed meanings of conceit, sensuality, superficiality

G. Dawn: The Crown of Beauty. The beginning of sovereignty and beauty. The primum mobile acting through the Moon upon the Sun. Change, alteration, increase or decrease. Fluctuation

Grimaud: The occult, intuition. The forces of nature. Safety, power over events, something hidden revealed, certainty triumphing over evil. A card of doors opening

Huson: Intuition reversed by hostility or hypocrisy

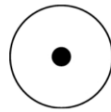

NUMBER MEANINGS, 1-10

You can find meanings for numbers 1 through 10 anywhere, but let's start with some basic keywords:

52. Sun (point and circle) glyph.



1:

Themes of unity: wholeness, immortality, potential

Themes of action: beginning, conception, initiative

Themes of self: assertiveness, independence, creativity, will



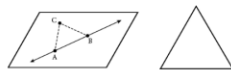
53. Line segment with endpoints, yin-yang symbol.

2:

Themes of balance: equilibrium, adaptability

Themes of opposition: polarity, electrical charge, choice, crossroads, challenges

Themes of the Other: insight, mirroring, romance, the "gaze," self-consciousness



54. Plane with points ABC, triangle.

3:

Page 199 of 398

Themes of birth: manifestation, movement, ambition

Themes of formation: control, realization, boundaries

Themes of community: community, collaboration, friendship, controls



55. Compass, square, triangle-based pyramid (tetrahedron).

4:

Themes of order: the family, discipline, the home, protection

Themes of accomplishment: business, money, respect

Themes of stability: boundaries, the elements of matter, stillness, earth, solidity



56. 5-point star, square-based pyramid.

5:

Themes of Disruption: freedom from the cycle of matter (4), spirituality, risk, change, imbalance

Themes of Creativity: travel, desire, sexuality, energy, attraction

Notes on Color Scale Correspondences for the Numeric Minor Arcana

You'll note that colors run thematically in rows—all fives have a reddish hue, which is characteristic of Geburah, the sephira of Severity, associated with Mars. To find the color associated with a numeric minor, check the suit column against the numeric row—for example, the 2 of Swords is bluish mother of pearl.

The planetary associations come from Kircher's model of the Tree of Life, as used by the Golden Dawn.
