Confusion, hesitation, inability to make decisive choices. Lack of inspiration or energy. Giving up easily, poor self image.




4 THE EMPEROR

Symbolizes the desire to rule over one's surroundings. Some things may not be controllable, others may not benefit from control.

Symbolizes the qualities needed to win the battle. They include selfreliance, righteousness, conviction and plain hard work.

A warning against overwhelming

The TAROT is a pack of 78 cards, which has been used from the mid-fifteenth century in various parts of Europe. It has four suits corresponding to the four suits of the modern 52-card pack and an additional 21 trump cards. Tarot cards are used primarily for divinatory purposes. Occultists call the trump cards and the Fool 'Major Arcana' while the ten pip and four court cards in each suit are called 'Minor Arcana'. The cards are traced by some occult writers to ancient Egypt or the Kabbalah. The lower sections give the readings for when the card is drawn upside-down.



2 THE HIGH PRIESTESS

Intuitiveness, understanding, wisdom, psychic ability, the divine feminine. Duality and mystery. Hidden female influences.

Lack of personal harmony and problems resulting from a lack of foresight. Suppression of the feminine or intuitive side.

5 THE HIEROPHANT

Symbol of moral law, a wise and capable advisor, a practical instructor and spiritual guide. Conventional and secure.





The Empress is mother, a creator and nurturer. Symbolic of the germination of an idea, the stage before it is ready to be fully born.


Domestic problems, financial difficulties, lack of affection and achievement. Creative blocks, unwanted pregnancy.

13 DEATH

Symbolizes a time of absolute endings and absolute beginnings. Abrupt and complete change of circumstances and way of life.

Stagnation, loss of opportunity, loss of friendship, fear of change. Agonizing periods of transition. Inertia, exhaustion.



16 THE TOWER

Sudden violent loss. Overthrow of an existing way of life. Re-evaluation, necessary change, a blessing in disguise.

Guilt, loss, self-reproach, delays, fear, obstinacy. Stagnation. Delay in concluding a series of actions. Fear of change, fear of death.




